

Two members join CVB Board of Directors

The Corpus Christi Convention & Visitors Bureau Board of Directors welcomes two new members to its roster: Daniel Dain of Domino's Pizza and Nils Stolzechner with Omni Hotels.

Dain and Stolzechner joined the CVB Board August 1, 2009. Dain owns eight Domino's Pizza stores in Corpus Christi and Portland, while Stolzechner works as the general manager of Omni Hotels.

They take their place on the Board alongside Board Chair John Trice, Immediate Past Chair Bill Morgan, Chair Elect Butch Pool, Treasurer Art Granado, Secretary Mark Schaberg, Jyoti Patel, Robert Tamez, Michael Womack and Tom Schmid.

Dain said he is committed to Corpus Christi and to the CVB adding that his main reason to be on the board is "to ensure that we promote our cities assets to visitors."

He began his career in 1984 as a delivery driver for Domino's Pizza in Plano, Texas and in 1990, moved up the ladder working as a manager and supervisor. It was in 1998 when Dain first franchised his own store. Today, he runs eight stores together with his wife, Katherine. Dain has always been involved in the community and has served on the Crime Control District Board and as commissioner with the Special Olympics Bayball Tournament fundraiser for eight years.

Stolzechner has worked in the hotel industry for much of his career starting in 1987 with Hyatt Hotels Corporation in San Francisco. In 1992, he moved to Switzerland where he worked for the upscale 60-room, resort, Hotel Pilatus, in Lucerne as its general manager. Seven years later, he returned to the United States where he worked as the director of food and beverage at San Ysidro Ranch in Santa Barbara, California moving in 2000 to the Highlands Inn in Carmel, California and again in 2001 to the Westin St. Francis in San Francisco. Stolzechner joined Omni Hotel in Los Angeles as its director of operations and acting general manager. In 2004, he took charge of the Boudin at Fisherman's Wharf as the director of operations and general manager. Omni Hotels called his name once again and Stolzechner returned as the hotel manager and director of operations in San Francisco. In 2006, Stolzechner found his home in Corpus Christi as general manager of the Omni Hotels.
