

Tall ships to SAIL into the Coastal Bend in 2010

Set sail for the Coastal Bend. The Port of Corpus Christi and the Buccaneer Commission announced at an August press conference the arrival of a tall ship festival, Sail South Texas 2010.

Sail 2010 will be July 1 through July 5, 2009 at the Port of Ingleside, formerly Naval Air Station-Ingleside and will celebrate sailing, history and independence of not only the United States, but of Latin American countries.

So far, one ship, The Cuautémoc from Mexico, has agreed to participate in the tall ship festival, but many more have been invited including the Capitan Miranda of Uruguay, the Cisne Branco of Brasil, the Esmeralda of Chile, the Gloria of Colombia, the Guayas of Ecuador, the Juan Sebastián Elcano of Spain, the Libertad of Argentina and the Simón Bolivar of Venezuela.
